BASED ON THE QUANTITY OF INCLUDED ENTRIES, SOME REGULAR CATEGORIES MAY TO BE SPLIT.

- In Aircraft categories: 1/100 refers to scales 1/87 and smaller; 1/72 refers to scales 1/86 to 1/60; 1/48 refers to scales 1/59 to 1/40; 1/32 refers to scales 1/39 and larger.
- In Military Vehicles categories: 1/72 refers to scales 1/100 to 1/60; 1/48 refers to scales 1/59 to 1/36; 1/35 refers to scales 1/35 and larger.
- In Figure categories: 1/32 and 1/35 figures will compete as 54mm.

CONTEST RULES

- 1.) The contest is open to all modelers. Membership in IPMS/USA is not a requirment.
- 2.) Models that have placed 3rd (bronze) or better in any IPMS National or Regional contest or at a previous Indianapolis IPMS chapter contest are not eligible for competition.
- 3.) Judging shall be conducted using the guidelines set forth by IPMS/USA. Entries will be judged using the following criteria Basic Construction, Overall Finish, Overall Accuracy, Additional Detailing and Degree of Difficulty. Scratchbuilt detail will be favored over commercially available detail if quality is comparable, A great amount of added detail will not make up for poor basic construction. A copy of the IPMS/USA Judges Handbook will be available for review.
- 4.) If a model is qualified for more than one category, the Registrars shall assist in determining which category the model should be entered. In the event of questionable placement, the Head Judge's decision will be final.
- 5.) The Contest Director may decline to accept an entry with subject matter that may be considered lewd, offensive or in poor taste by the general public.
- 6.) Contest categories may be expanded or combined, at the discretion of the Head Judge, based on the number of entries in a given category.
- 7.) Jet aircraft categories include manned, rocket powered vehicles such as the Me-163, X-1, X-15 etc.
- 8.) Bases: A simple base* and the primary crew figures will be allowed with an entry, however the addition of any other figures or equipment outside, or not attached to the model (e.g. support equipment, foliage, shell splashes, or buildings) will make the model a Diorama, which then shall be entered in the proper Diorama Category. A scene of action will be considered a diorama. Bases and figures will not be judged in non-diorama categories. *Max entry/base size is 900 Sq In (30" x 30")
- 9.) Dioramas are defined as scenes telling a story, containing figures and vehicles (aircraft, tanks, ships, cars and trucks.)

- 10.) OUT OF THE ROX: To be considered out of the box a kit must be constructed solely from the contents of the kit, with the exception of finishes and decals. Weathering, filling seams and molding flaws, adding simple seat beats, and antennae/rigging are allowed. Gun barrels, vents and door handles may be drilled out as well. No cutting/separating/opening of hatches, control surfaces, canopies, or doors is permitted. The use of aftermarket accessories (except decals) will be cause for disqualification from the Out-of-Box category. Instructions MUST accompany the model and entry form.
- 11.) A "Conversion" entry must contain significant structural changes to the basic kit involving extensive changes in contour or configuration, such work having been accomplished by the modeler. Entries using aftermarket parts as the MAJORITY of the conversion will be placed in the appropriate regular category.
- 12.) A Scratchbuilt entries may incorporate minor parts from other kits (wheels, guns, ordnance etc.), but the mojority of the main subject should not be from a commercially manufactured kit.
- 13,) All dust covers MUST be removed prior to judging, Models with dust covers on will not be considered during judging,
- 14.) NO SWEEPS ALLOWED. A modeler will be awarded the single highest award earned in a particular category.
- 15,) Interference with the Judges during the judging process may result in an entrant's immediate disqualification,
- 16.) The Judges decisions are final,
- 17.) The IPMS/ROSCOE TURNER CHAPTER, its members, agents, or officers assume no liability or responsibility in case of accidents involving attendees, equipment, merchandise, models, displays or for property lost, stolen, or damaged during the
